

A Graphic Explaining Autism to Children

Using a wheelchair





Sometimes people have differences which you can't see, like having a brain which is wired differently...






Sometimes this different wiring in the brain in known as autism

Autistic people might know lots about the topics we are interested in. We might like to share about these topics...






Autistic people may like routines and focus on the small details...






Autistic people may become overwhelmed by things you might not notice, like...

We might struggle to communicate with you, even if we really want to be friends




Sometimes we might move our bodies in order to help us cope and feel better. We might...



How can you help autistic people?




Invite us to sit with you at lunchtime.

Chat to us about our interests.




Help us find a trusted adult if we seem overwhelmed.




Allow us extra time to do things.


